



## National Art Competition, Show and Sale Cheyenne Artists Guild 2010

Cheyenne Artists Guild celebrates its 40th Art Competition Show and Sale by inviting artists from all 50 states to participate. The gratifying success of our previous shows encourages us to continue offering this opportunity to the artist community.

### Eligibility

Work previously exhibited in Cheyenne Artists Guild Juried Shows and Competitions may not be resubmitted. All accepted artwork must be for sale, still owned by the artist, and created within the last three years. 2-D work only. Original work in any eligible medium and of any subject or style may be submitted.

Portrait

Landscape

Still Life

Non-Traditional

### Not Accepted in this Competition:

Sculpture, photography, reproductions and computer generated works. Art that is a copy of other artists' work will be rejected. Size is limited to outside frame perimeter of not more than 180 inches.

June 14 - Monday

Deadline for Receipt of Entries: completed entry form, photos or CD's fees, and SASE.

June 21 - Monday

Notification mailed of jury results.

July 28 - Wednesday

Final Days for Accepting Artwork: hand delivered or shipped 12pm to 4:00pm. No work will be accepted after 4pm, August 20<sup>th</sup>.

July 29-31 - Thursday-Saturday

Show prep and hanging artwork

August 3 - Tuesday

Show opens to the public at the Cheyenne Artists Guild Gallery in Holliday Park.

August 31 - Tuesday

Last Day for Exhibit.

September 1-10 - Wednesday

Deadline for Retrieving Entries; shipped artwork will be sent out.

### Awards

- ✍ Cash prizes (to be determined by number of entries and sponsorships) will be awarded to the winners.
- ✍ Cash awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup> Place in each category, Best of Show, and Honorable Mention.
- ✍ Winners will be notified soon after the judging.
- ✍ Awards will be mailed at the close of the Show. Artists not in attendance may receive a catalog if an **additional** SASE is included at time of entry.

Cheyenne Artists Guild reserves the right to photograph paintings for publicity or catalog.

### Submission Procedures

Artists may enter any number of 4"x 6" prints or CD. No slides. Images on CD must be in jpg format. CD and Photos must be labeled with:

Artist's Name

Title of Work

Medium

Outside Frame Size

Price

Top side should be indicated

A non-refundable fee of \$12.00 per entry will be charged. Make checks or money orders payable to Cheyenne Artists Guild. Entry Form must be properly and legibly filled out and signed. A 25% commission will be retained by the Guild on all sales.

**All work should be insured by the artist. The Cheyenne Artists Guild will not assume any liability for damage to work while in its possession. Prudent care will be taken of all art.**

Images of accepted work will become the property of the Cheyenne Artists Guild and securely stored as permanent records. All other images will be returned only if accompanied by a self addressed stamped envelope (SASE)

### Display, Frames, & Plexiglass

All work must arrive show ready: appropriately framed, matted and/or mounted. Acetate coverings, brackets, quick frames or any type clamp leaving exposed glass edges will not be accepted. Tape wire ends and use plexiglass for media under glass. Sturdy screw-eyes/hangers and strong wire only.

### Packaging Artwork

No packaging peanuts allowed, foam packing preferable, no tape over bubble wrap. The artist is responsible for all delivery and return shipping costs.
